
Communication begins here...

What we can Learn with Sign Language

Sign language is a visual language, not a written language like English, French, Dutch. Because it is visual language it has to be as visual as possible and is therefore a great way of learning how to

communicate using non-verbal communication.

Sign language itself has its own and unique grammar rules and foundation because it is strongly influenced by the Deaf community's cultural attributes such as facial expressions, gestures, usage of space.

The language itself may seem superficial from the outside but if you sink deeper, there's much more to the language itself. It is about creating connection and communicating from the heart. Students will interact with teachers from the Deaf community and magic can happen when you put together members of community who take hearing for granted and the hearing impaired. If communication can take place, what more can we achieve when we can use all our senses.


